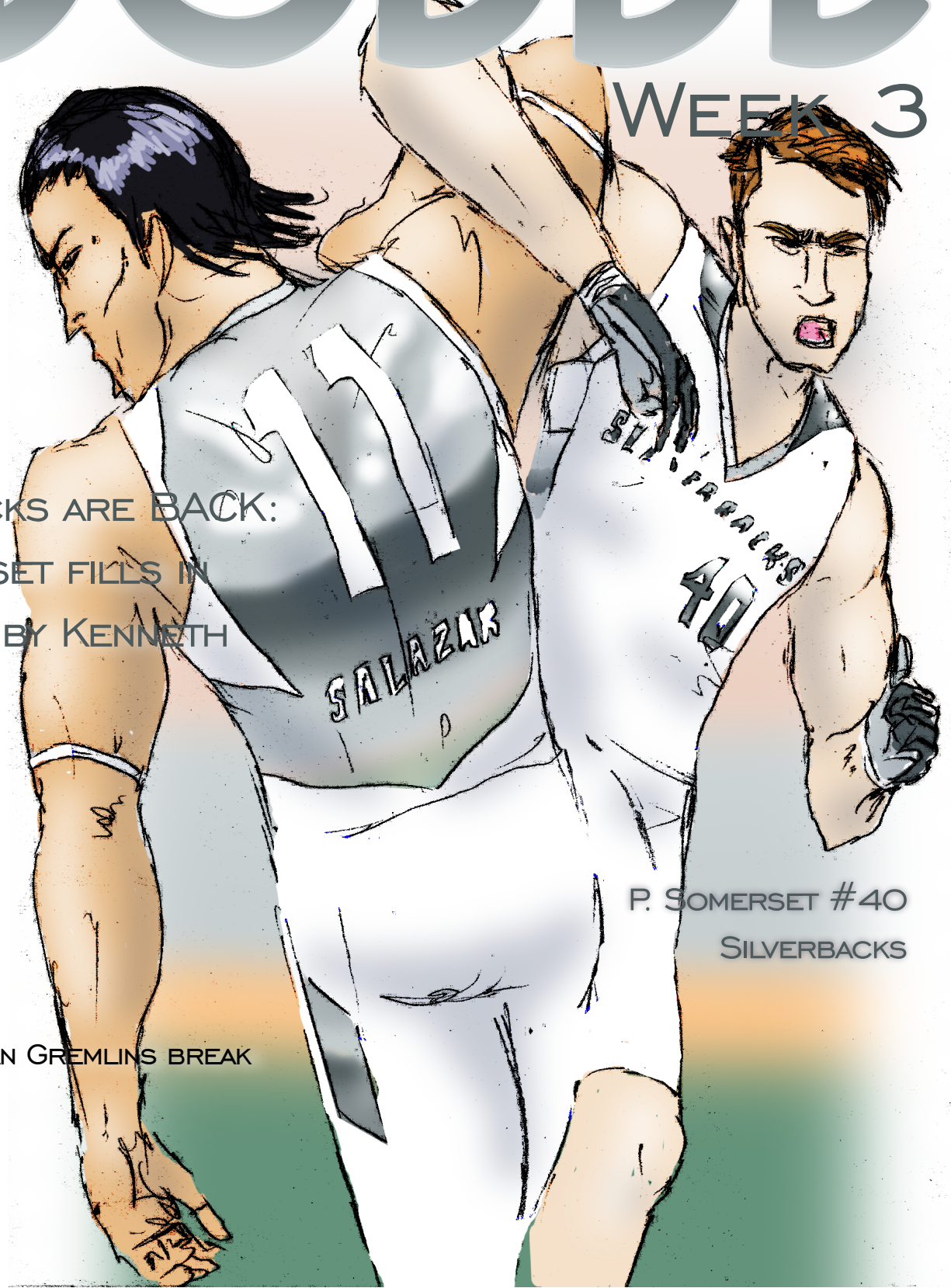

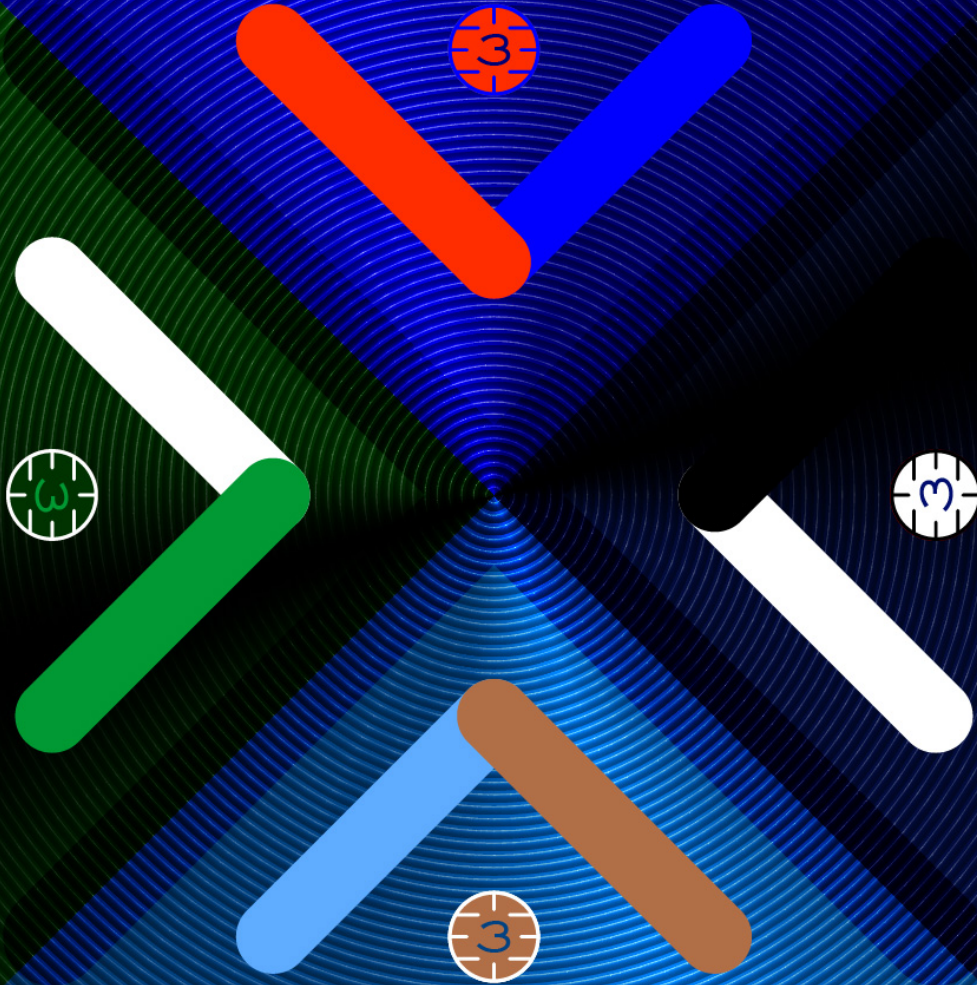

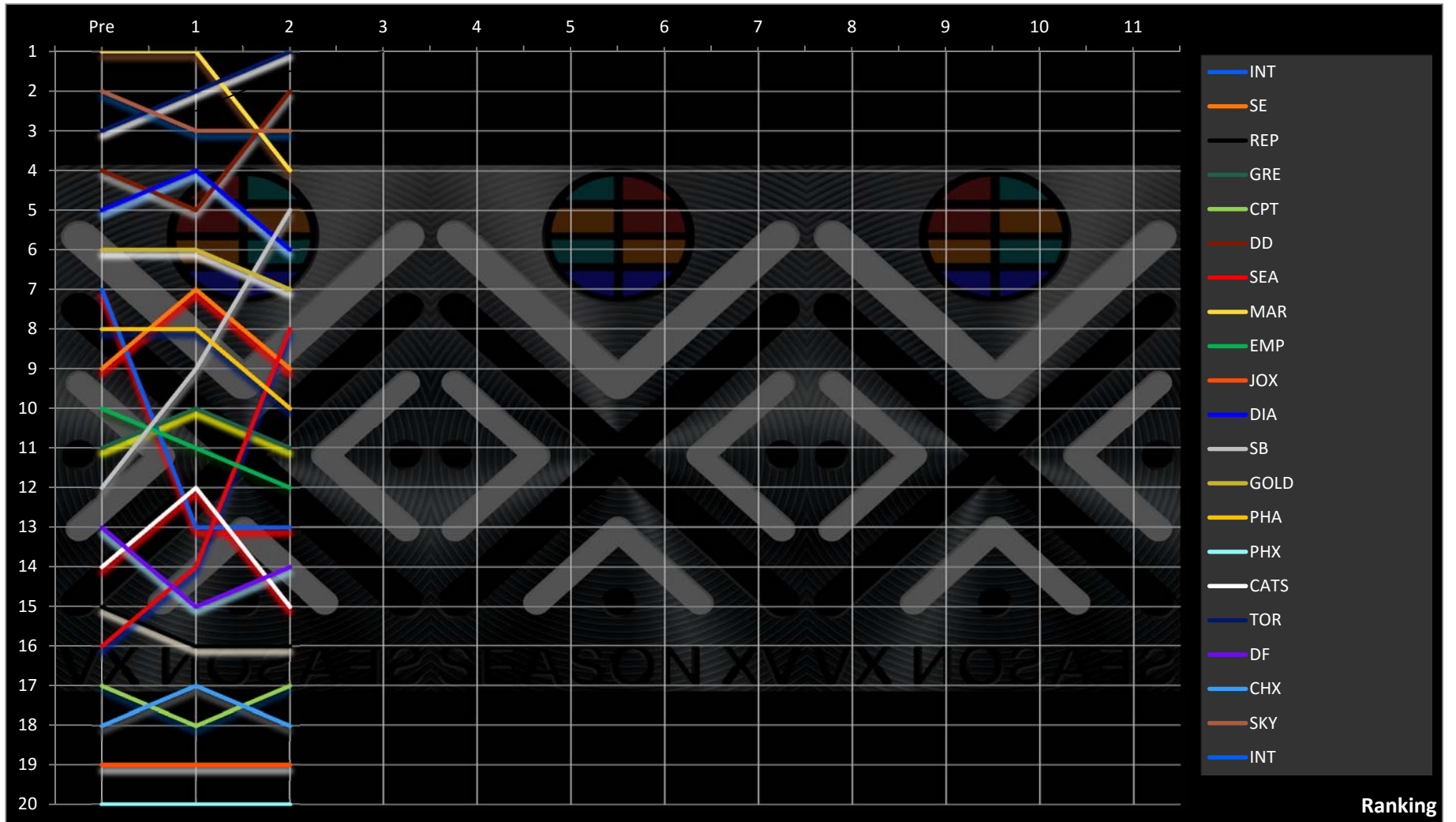

Going into the preseason tournament, the Gremlins went in with a certain hype no one else in the league had. Could a team of 5 deep, solid, but not great, players be a way to success rather than the 2 to 3 star approach most teams were using? They ripped into their debut Tourney game, ranked #5 with ease, beating the #3 Scarlet Ember. Many around the league were thinking Coach Pulin might be a genius. But the. Reality hit, the Gremlins finished out the Tourney at 2-2.

Going into the season, Pulin pulled Casey from the Captain role and handed it to new rookie T. Mills. "We feel he gives us the best direction, and he really vibes with the other players and we may as well introduce him as our rock for the future now." Well, the first game was an instant classic in Oklahoma City on the flex against rival Reapers. The game was solidly even down to the last set. But, the team wasn't very cohesive.

This problem seemed to grow going into their home debut against the Captains. This was supposed to be an easy win, a show of strength to let the fans know the Midwest can't count these guys out yet. -- Then they met Travis. "I've played countless games here and I don't remember ever feeling that stupid, so dismissive of a team with a solid roster." Casey. The Captains mounted a 4-0 lead before the Gremlins were able to stabilize the ship, using their depth. Melisizwe carried a set, J. Woods, Casey and even Mills got in on some action. She held it for a little bit with a couple dodges and a throw out, but the tide was overwhelming.

The Gremlins are 0-2. Last in the division. Yet, there is nothing but post season hopes, still, if you ask Casey about it. "To be honest, this division is wiiiiiiide open. We have opportunity to play in the weakest division in the league. The rankings prove it, no one in the top 8. After the South ravaged both of our perennial powerhouses, no one is to be feared! It is with this spirit and front running play that Pulin announced Tuesday that Casey was getting the team's reins returned back to her. The Gremlins need the confidence and steady hand she provides.
